Integrated forest ecosystem management and demonstration project In greater Mekong sub-region (Myanmar) Completion Report on Training on making broom grass

Introduction

- 1. With the funded of Asia-Pacific Network for sustainable forest management and rehabilitation (APFNet), Forest Research Institute (FRI) is implementing the integrated forest ecosystem management and demonstration project in greater Mekong sub-region (Myanmar) in Paung Laung reserve forest and FRI. In Paung Laung integrated watershed area, establishment of agroforestry demonstration plots are being conducted with the community participation.
- 2. Leinli village, located in the Paung Laung watershed area, is one of the forest-dependent village with about 140 households. Farming and production of non-timber forest are carried out to generate income for the family. It was found that the main production is broom (about 50,000 tons per year) and bamboo (more than 100,000 tons per year).
- 3. Establishment of 117 acres of agroforestry demonstration plots with the planting of forest trees, fruit trees, bamboo and annual/seasonal crops, support to produce finished/valuable products from local raw materials, providing training on the development of non-timber forest product are conducted with the support of project activities in Leinli village, project site. The practical teaching of how to make a broom that will be taught is an open lecture aimed at producing and selling the finished product from the raw material of the broom grass.

Objectives

- 4. This training was established for the following objectives
 - a) To realize the importance of non-timber forest products
 - b) To learn how to produce finished/valuable products from broom grass
 - c) To increase family income by producing and selling brooms

Training Period

5. The training was held 18.01.2024 to 20.01.2024.

Training Place

6. The training was held Lein Li village, Pin Laung Township, Shan State.

 - c) planning of teaching work;

 - a) Project profile and training introduction
 - b) Important role of non-timber forest
 - c) Practical teaching on how to make a broom from the broom grass

On ground training

10. Practice how to make valuable product of broom grass from raw material with the process steps. Lecture by the U Moe Zaw (Director), Dr. Ei Ei Swe Hlaing (Assistant Director), U Zaw Min Aye (Staff Officer) and on ground/practical work teach by local industry (Daw Mone, Daw Mya Mya and Daw Thidar Moe) who are career by making brooms.

List of the Trainees

11. 30 trainees: Local villagers from the project area where located at the Lainli village, Pinlaung Township, Shan State. Trainees list is attached in appendix (3)

Cost for Training

12. Training cost was funded by the integrated forest ecosystem management and demonstration project in greater Mekong sub-region (Myanmar), FD-APFNet IFEM Project.

Summary of Training

- 13. First of all, how to cut broom grass and collecting method were taught from the forest near the village. After that, the cut broom plants must be dried for 5 to 7 days depending on the weather. After the brooms are dry enough, remove the hair, cleaning, initial process of selecting and cutting to the required size using a knife.
- 14. After the cleaning, to start tying the broom (tying small knots for tying the broom); Gathering brooms tying/gathering with rods using a sharp point; Using plastic rope and using soft pipe and braiding/gathering; How to make small brooms using bamboo and trim them when finished. adjusting the handle; Practical teaching and practice were taught on methods such as installing hook hangers.

Discussion

15. Local people asked in their township there is no market demand for brooms. So, how to sell brooms for their livelihood. Project team will provide market linkage with locals and Commodity depot for long-term purpose. They also want to export brooms from their village, so they wanted to valuable product of broom grass with high technologies for the highly

export. They said, today training was very useful and helpful technologies for their livelihood and will be good income because project team made market linkage with the locals.

Feedback from Trainees

- 16. After the training, following feedback were received from the trainees -
 - ✓ They are used to sell broom grass as raw materials before. Now they understand how to make broom to use in their home as well as to sell in the market.
 - ✓ They can earn extra income at home by making broom.
 - ✓ It is very good training for the women for getting knowledge on various methods of making broom and for social gathering to learn and talk each other in the training.
 - ✓ Training venue is at the village so that they are very convenient to come and join from their home especially for the women.
 - ✓ Thanks to APFNet and project team members for supporting foods, T-shirt and other materials to make brooms.

Documentary

17. Photo documentory and training records were taken by the project team and documentaries photo were attached in appendix (4).

Conclusion

18. To support rural development by teaching how to make a broom, by producing and selling non-timber forest products from raw materials to finished products, increasing the per capita income of families. It is reported that the importance of the value of non-timber forest products will be improved.
